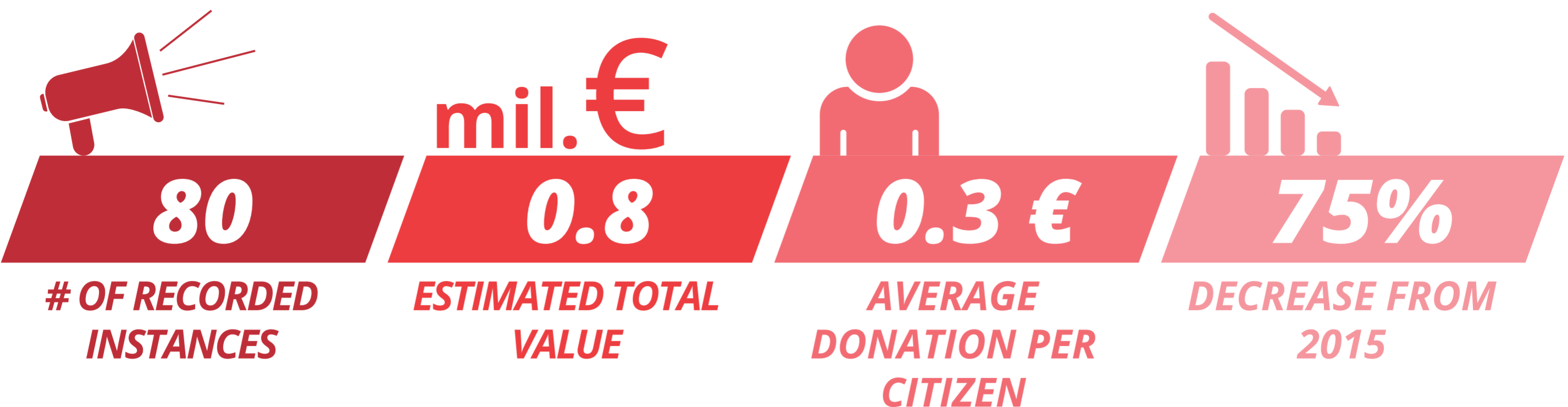

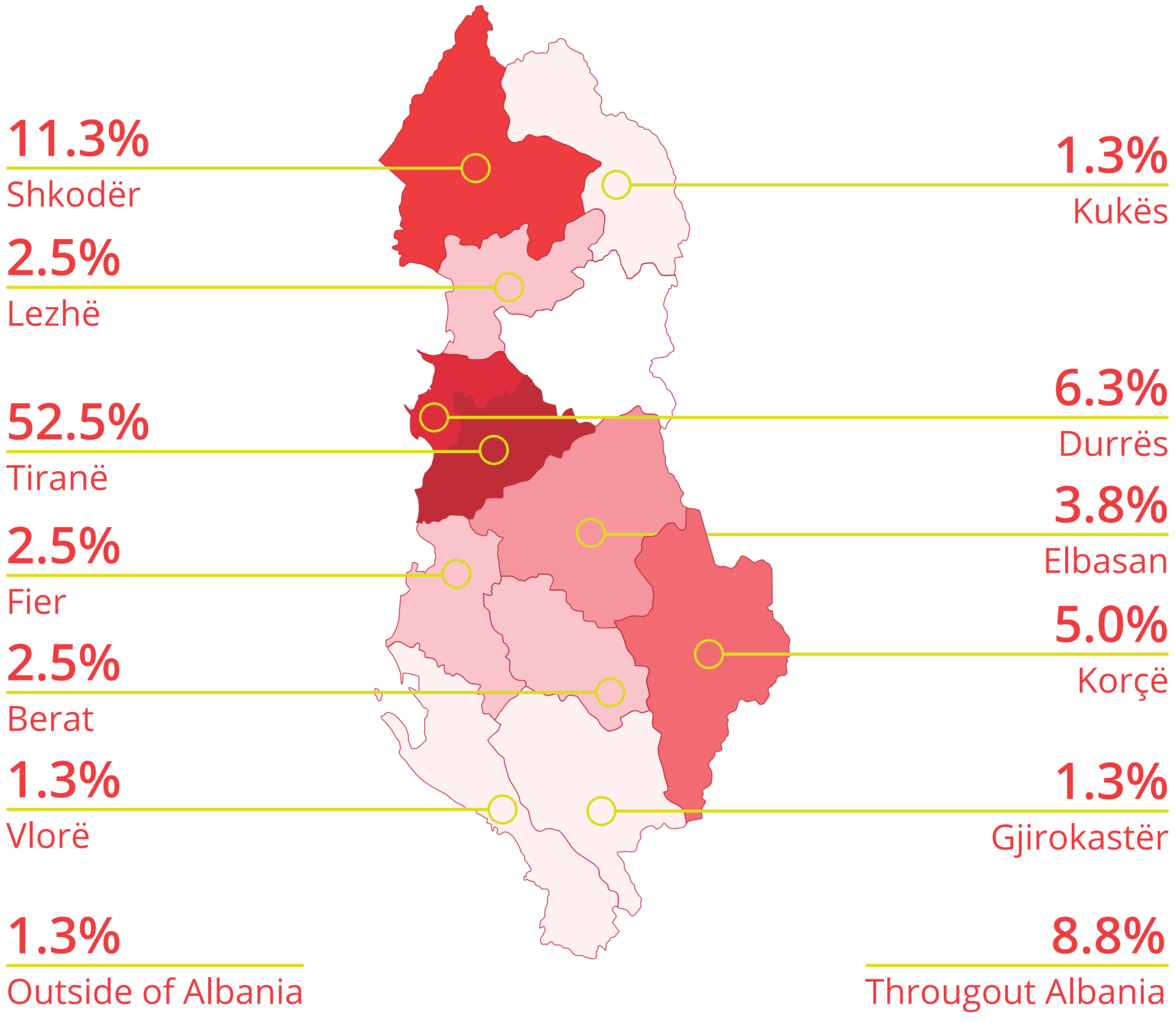

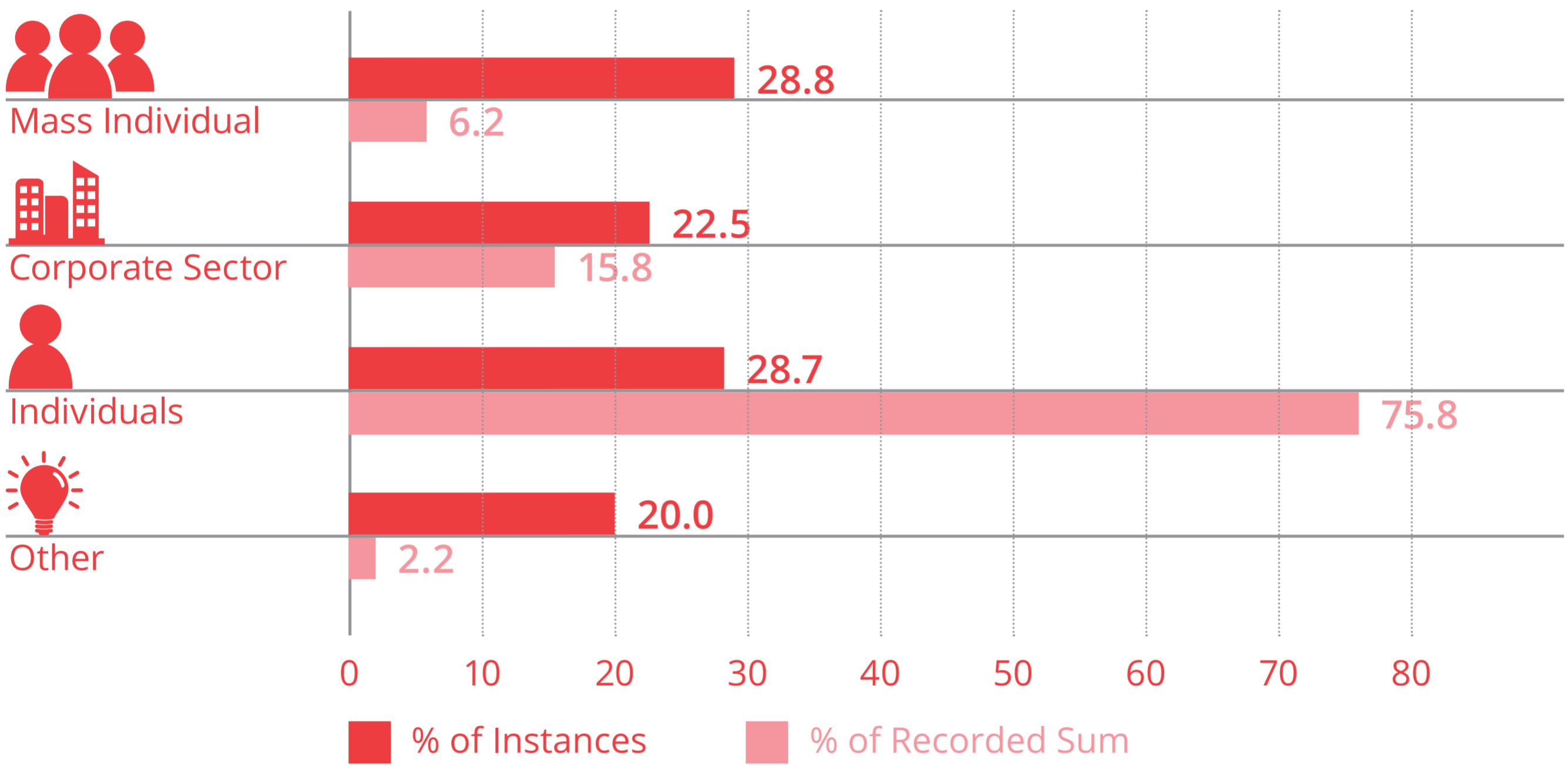

### GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

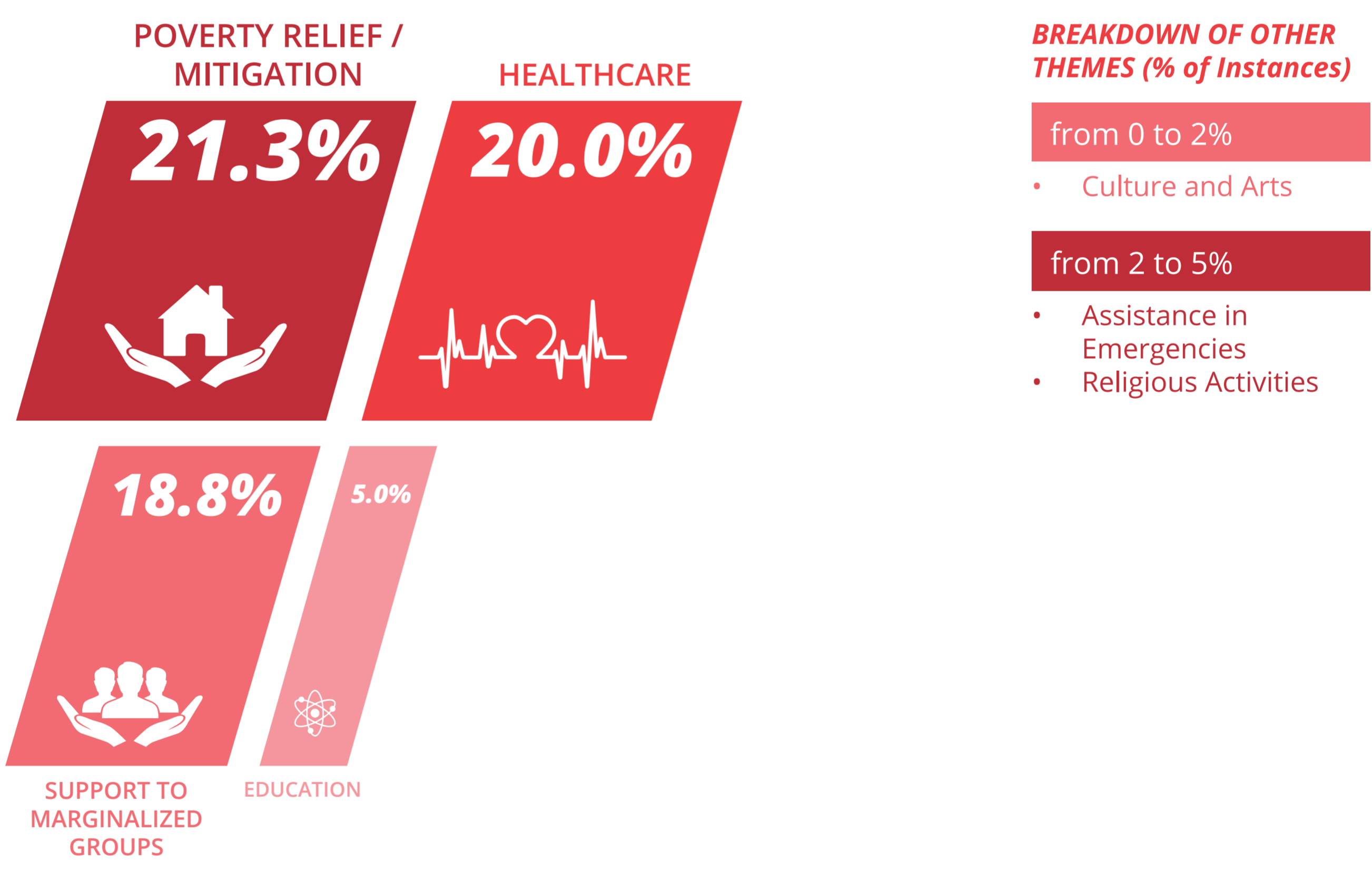

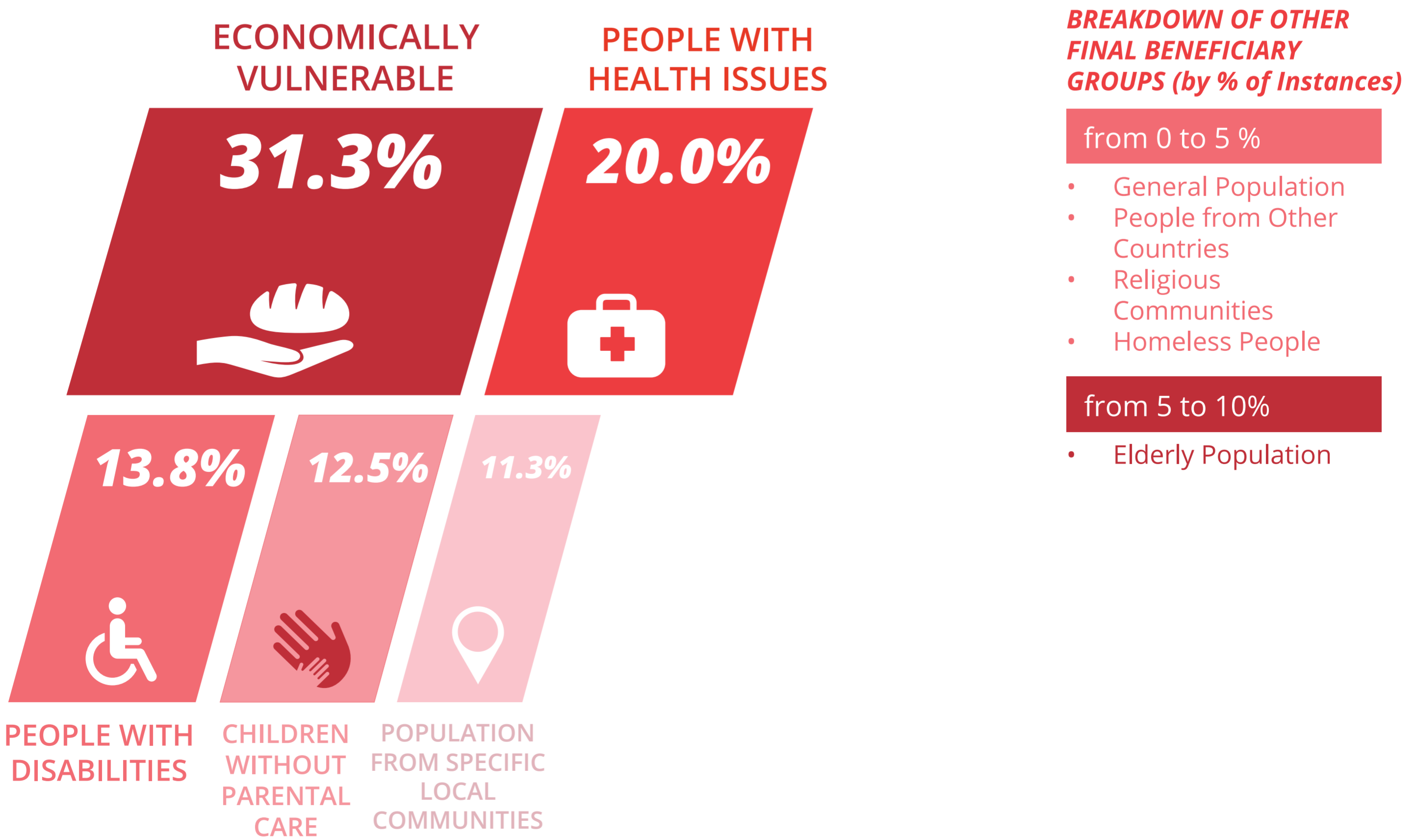
DONATIONS BY TYPE OF DONORS  
(% of Instances vs. % of Recorded Sum)



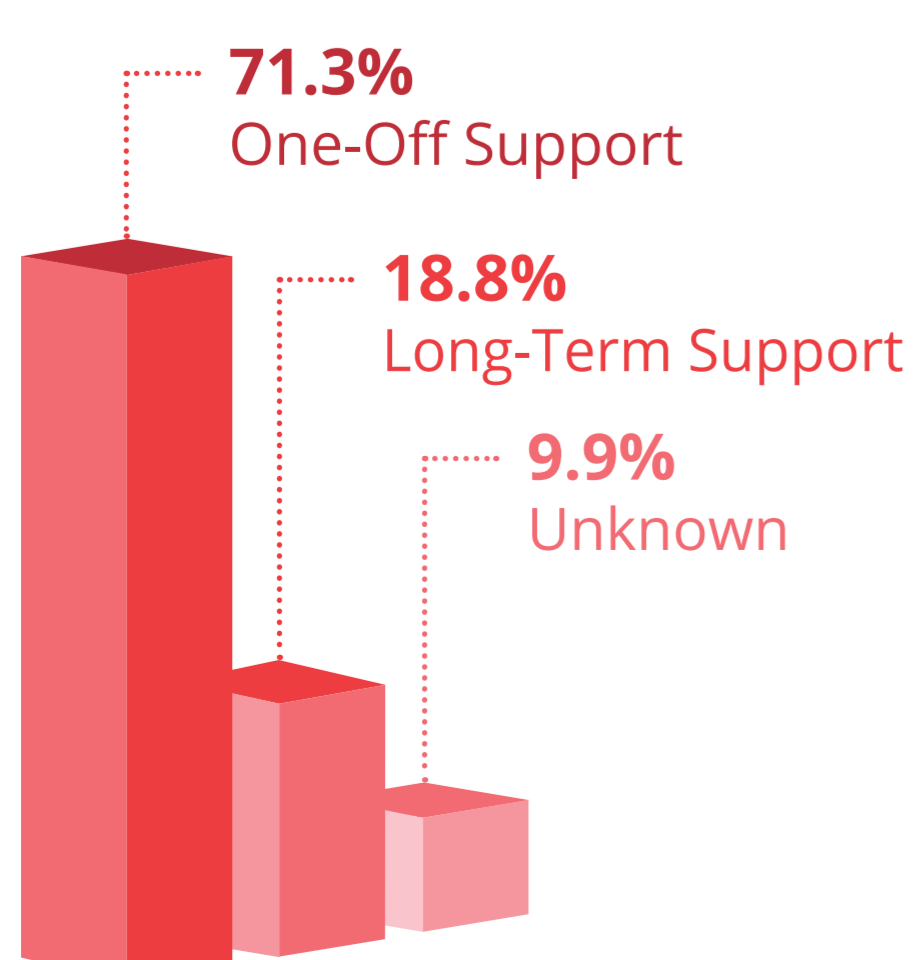
